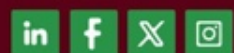

1. RULES OF ORIGIN MANUAL

Determines product eligibility for preferential treatment under the **AfCFTA**.



2. AfCFTA E-TARIFF BOOK

Provides tariff schedules and market access information across State Parties.



3. NTB REPORTING MECHANISM

Enables businesses to report and resolve non-tariff barriers online.



4. PAN-AFRICAN PAYMENT AND SETTLEMENT SYSTEM (PAPSS)

Facilitates instant cross-border payments in local African currencies.



5. AFRICA TRADE GATEWAY (ATG)

Provides trade intelligence, market data and business insights.



6. AfCFTA ADJUSTMENT FUND

Supports countries and businesses in adapting to the AfCFTA transition.
